

Folk-Dance etiquette

- Thanks for wearing your NAME tag! It is really, really helpful.
- In line- and circle-dances, to avoid wrestling, give your right hand palm up, left hand palm down.
- Learning a new dance ? Dance next to a good dancer. If you know the dance, move next to someone who's struggling.
- Join a dance at the END of a line or at the BOTTOM of a set.
- Be thoughtful about any rings you wear.
- Use sense when using scents.
- Say "hello" to dancers whose names you don't recognize (or even if you do)- it might be the person who's considering joining BFD!
- You don't have to know every dance perfectly to dance and have fun!
- If you DON'T know a dance, step behind the line to learn the steps, or even sit one out.
